Student Photo Upload instructions

- 1. For your photo to be accepted it will need to be:
 - a. a clear, passport style, recent headshot, with you facing forward and looking straight at the camera
 - b. your eyes must be open and clearly visible (with no sunglasses or tinted glasses and no hair across your eyes)
 - c. of your full head, without any covering, unless it is worn for religious beliefs or medical reasons
 - d. of you on your own (with no other people visible)
 - e. in colour, not black and white
 - f. be upright (i.e. vertical, portrait) we cannot rotate images once submitted
 - g. be approximately 150 pixels wide by 180 pixels high and .jpg format
- 2. Login to your intranet account at https://intranet.swan.ac.uk
- 3. Go to the student profile summary page (this is the default page outside of enrolment periods, otherwise click on the link from the enrolment page)
